

Revising bribes, tricks, secrets and coercion

Rho says:

A **bribe** is when someone offers something like money, gifts or other treats so someone else will do what they want. If someone ever tries to bribe you into breaking the body rules, tell your trusted adults immediately!

People who break the body rules can be very good at **trick**-ing children into thinking it's a game, or into doing something they didn't mean to. Always tell your trusted adults if someone tricks you into breaking the body rules!



Adults who break the body rules know they're also breaking the law, which is why they want to keep it a **secret**. If someone asks you to keep breaking the body rules a secret, tell your trusted adults immediately!

To **coerce** someone means to pressure them into doing something they don't want to do. Someone might coerce a child into breaking the body rules by making them feel scared, promising them something in return, or making the child feel like it was their fault. People who use these tactics to get children to break the body rules do so because they know they're breaking the law! If someone coerces you into breaking the body rules, tell your trusted adults immediately!
